Join us for a voyage into the distant past. Along the way we will travel to Iron Age, Roman, Anglo-Saxon, Viking, and Norman sites and museums in Great Britain. Hike a section of Hadrian's Wall; enter ruinous Roman forts and soaring Norman castles and churches; visit Roman towns, villas, baths, theaters, amphitheaters, temples; gaze upon myth-inspired floor mosaics and Christian wall paintings; and study abundant archaeological artifacts displayed in regional and national museums.

This study abroad program will emphasize the importance of knowledge sharing: every student will research and present to the group a site or artifact and these will be augmented by on-site introductions by expert guest scholars and archaeologists from British universities.
