UNSW Study Abroad & Exchange Students are eligible to apply for on-campus accommodation in The Kensington Colleges (Basser, Goldstein & Philip Baxter), Fig Tree Hall, Colombo House, UNSW Hall, University Terraces, Barker Apartments & Mulwarree Apartments. Located on UNSW's Kensington Campus, on-campus accommodations are situated cose to transport, shops, cafes, and bars. Availability for Study Abroad & Exchange Students in each residence is subject to current occupancy.

Licence period

The accommodation licence period commences on 13 July 2018 and concludes on 29 November 2018.

The housing includes:

- Utility charges (electricity, gas & water).
- Internet
- · Cleaning and maintenance.
- · Furniture and fixtures.

Additional charges:

- AU\$100 application fee.
- AU\$66 end of contract cleaning fee.
- AU\$550 in the event of misconduct.

Catered accommodation

The Kensington Colleges (Basser, Goldstein, Philip Baxter)

Cost per semester:

UNSW Hall

UNSW Hall is an option that provides great value for money in an older style accommodation. A part-catered, residential college experience, with social, cultural and sporting activities included in fees for all residents. All residents share mixed gender bathrooms.

Cost per semester:

Single room with mixed gender bathroom AU\$7,628

Fig Tree Hall

Unlike any other college community at UNSW, Fig Tree Hall is fully catered, alcohol free and offers some strictly male and female only floors. All rooms have their own private bathroom.

Cost per semester:

- Single room with private bathroom AU\$11,410
- Gown fee AU\$60

Self-catered accommodation

University Terraces (limited availability)

Located on campus, the Terraces are close to transport, shops, cafés, bars and the on campus supermarket. University Terraces has indoor and outdoor social and study spaces, and each apartment is fully self-contained with own kitchenette and bathroom.

Cost per semester:

Single room in 2 bedroom apartment AU\$8,056

Colombo House (limited availability)

A unique self-catered college community located adjacent to the Kensington Colleges at mid-campus. This accommodation is ideally suited to students who enjoy the benefits of a well-integrated community life but enjoy a sense of independence.

Cost per semester:

Single room with private bathroom AU\$8,346

Barker Apartments (limited availability)

Set in landscaped gardens and located on campus, you'll be living in a cluster of apartments of 5 residents with your own bedroom and shared facilities/common areas. You'll be doing your own cooking/cleaning, so this is suited to those seeking more independent living arrangements.

Mulwarree Apartments (limited availability)

A short skip and a jump from the University (approx 15-20min walk), Mulwarree Apartments are set amongst beautifully landscaped gardens in the neighbourhood of Randwick and offer a truly independent style of living. Students live in a cluster of 5-person apartments with individual bedrooms and shared bathroom and common areas. Live like a true Sydney-sider surrounded by local shops, the Royal Randwick Racecourse and heaps more.

Cost per semester:

Terms and conditions

Securing a Place

If selected for UNSW on-campus accommodation, a non-refundable fee in advance payment of A\$1,000 is required to secure a housing reservation. The fee in advance payment will be subtracted from the total semester's accommodation fee.

Withdrawal prior to arrival in Sydney

The fee in advance payment is not refundable should you choose to withdraw from UNSW Student Accommodation housing.

Withdrawal upon arrival in Sydney

If you wish to withdraw from UNSW Student Accommodation housing, written notice must be provided to the Student Accommodation office. Students will be responsible for the full semester's housing costs, unless they can find an appropriate replacement to take over their housing contract. All replacements are subject to UNSW Student Accommodation office approval.

Roommate requests

You may **only** request to live with another student in the University Terraces. Roommate requests are not guaranteed and are subject to UNSW Student Accommodation approval. All requests must be mutual and should be emailed upon completion of application to **accommodation@unsw.edu.au**.

Arrival and Checking-In

If you are not collected at the airport by the UNSW Study Abroad & Exchange airport pick-up service then you must inform the Study Abroad office and UNSW Student Accommodation of your check-in details (date and time).

Please note to check in individually you should go to the Study Abroad Office at Room G30, John Goodsell building UNSW between

9am to 5pm Monday to Friday.

Personal Insurance

UNSW Student Accommodation will impose penalties and/or fines for breaches to the licence agreement. These fines may include UNSW security call-out fees and/or misconduct fees. Violation of the UNSW Student Accommodation licence agreement may result in penalties or eviction.
